## Practise activity:

1. Click in the address bar, where it says **www.learnmyway.com**.
2. Delete **www.learnmyway.com** type **www.gov.uk** then press **Enter**.
3. When the website has loaded, look on the right hand side, below the blue band, for a link to the **Money and tax** section. Select the link.
4. When the Money and tax section has loaded, look down the main list in the centre of the screen and select **Court claims, debt and bankruptcy**. A new menu will appear to the right.
5. From the new menu, look down the menu for a link about **options for dealing with your debts**. Select the link.
6. Find and select the link to the **Money Advice Service**.
7. Find the **Debt & Borrowing** section at the top of the screen, then select the **Debt Advice Locator**.
8. Open one of the websites listed under the **Online debt advice services** section.
9. Make a note of the website you've got to.
10. If you have time left feel free to explore the internet even more.
