This course is for learners who wish to progress to the Level 2 Care course. On completion of this course, you will receive a certificate of completion. **It is recommended that you attend this course before enrolling for the L2 Care diploma qualification course**

This 6 week introductory course will include topics such as:

- Job opportunities in health and social care
- Communication within health and social care
- The skills and qualifications needed for jobs in health and social care

This Non Accredited course will cover knowledge on:

- **Understanding you own role and responsibilities in adult social care**
- **Understanding Personal development in adult social care settings**
- **Understanding Duty of care in adult social care**
- **Understanding Equality, diversity, inclusion and human rights in adult social care**
- **Understanding Communication in adult social care**

To attend this course and complete the coursework, you need access to a good internet connection and a laptop, computer or tablet device.

ENQUIRE

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These courses are free for those who meet all the following funding requirements:

- you live in a London /Wandsworth Borough*
 - you are not in full time education
 - you have not achieved this qualification before
 - you are aged 19 or older on 31st August 2024
 - Have permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months from the first day of learning
- If you don't have permission to live in the UK for 12 months from the first day of learning there are exemptions which can be discussed with the IAG advisor that will contact you.**
